## 1. Staff Interpretation & Understanding

In its current form, the proposal is not clear for staff to understand, interpret and implement as written.

## 2. Comments

### a. Staff Comments

The following omissions need to be added to the proposal:

- The title of the proposal is vague about whether this is an intra-RIR or inter-RIR transfer policy.
- Section 2, which is meant to be a summary of how the proposal addresses the problem in Sec 1, introduces a separate topic about transfers of legacy resources. This is a very critical issue that should be introduced separately in Section 3 and be removed from the summary section.
- Definition or classification of the various types of transfers and a detailed process on how AFRINIC will conduct each of those transfers is missing in Sec 3.
- Sec 3b mentions "exhaustion" of IPv4 space – this is ambiguous – and should be clear on whether this refers to the start of issuance from the last /8, or the invocation of the soft-landing policy.
- Sec 3.1b refers to "same business entity". This needs to be properly defined in order not to confuse AFRINIC staff with interpretation.
- Sec 3 needs to be a complete description of the proposal. A reader who ignores the title, section 1, and section 2, but reads section 3, needs to be able to understand the entire proposal.

## 1. Staff Interpretation & Understanding

The policy attempts to define what percentage of the number resources allocated to an AFRINIC member can be used outside of the AFRINIC service region.

## 2. Comments

### a. Staff Comments

Staff has observed the following issues:

- Sec 3b – the reference of “time z” appears not necessary. Also edit “if x be the allocation size” to “if x be the total space allocated to the member”.
- Sec 3c – the proposal needs to be as clear as possible on what methods AFRINIC staff shall use to measure resources used out-of-region from any given allocation, instead of leaving this to the discretion of AFRINIC staff. For example, if there is a VPN or tunnel in which the server is in the AFRINIC service region but the client is outside the region, then does this count as in-region or out-of-region use?

### b. Legal Adviser’s Assessment & Comments

Replace content of Clause 3f with: *“To all intents and purposes, this proposed policy shall be read and applied in addition to any such existing AFRINIC policy(ies) governing the same subject matter”.*

## 4. Summary & Recommendations

As written, the proposal will present issues to implement, especially Clause 3c, which gives AFRINIC staff discretion on determining how to compute resources used out-of-region. The method of computation needs to be explicitly defined in this policy proposal.
