Subject: Ratification of Policy Proposal (AFPUB-2018-V6-001-DRAFT01 - IPv6 Policy & References Update).

Dear Sirs,

In line with the AFRINIC Policy Development Process, we would like to inform you that the above mentioned policy proposal reached consensus at the last face-to-face meeting held in Dakar on May 5th 2018 during AfrINIC-28 Public Policy Meeting. The last call period ended on June 18th 2018.

The proposals are composed of updates to existing text in the Consolidated Policy Manual. The staff assessments indicated that these proposal can be implemented as written with no impact to AFRINIC operations - hence, these proposals received mostly support from the community at the meeting.
